

# Walking Animals

## Making Guide



### Step 1:

#### Create Head

Make a ball of foil or newspaper and tape and shape it into the shape of your animals head



### Materials List:

- Scissors
- Tape
- Glue
- String
- Cardboard Tube
- Foil/Newspaper
- Wooden Skewers
- Beads/Bottle Tops
- Pipe Cleaners
- Decorative Bits

### Step 3: Assembly

To attach the head to the body, cut a length of string 2cm longer than what you want your neck length to be. Using tape secure one end of the string to the base of your head and the other end to the inside of the top of your cardboard tube.



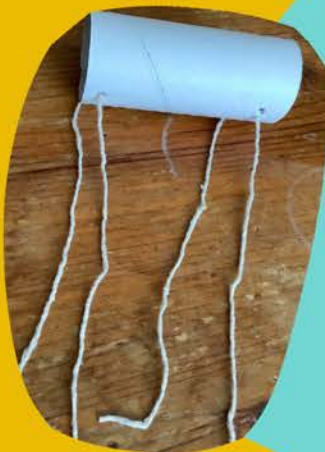
### Step 2:

#### Making Legs

Carefully poke 4 holes into your cardboard tube. Make sure that 2 are level with each other at one end and the other 2 are level with each other at the other end of the tube.



Next cut two equal lengths of string of about 15cm. You can make them longer or shorter as your animal requires. Thread one piece of string through the two level holes at one end and the other piece of string through the other 2 holes. Now you have 4 dangling legs.



### Step 4: Handles

Cut 2 Wooden skewers to a comfortable length for you to hold. Insert one in the back of your puppets head, insert the other at the back of the cardboard tube. Secure them using glue and tape.



Add feet to the bottom of your legs by tying beads or plastic bottle caps with holes punched into them on to the ends of the string legs.

For stiffer legs you can use pipe cleaners instead of string!



### Step 5: Decorate!

Using coloured paper, paint, stickers, beads, pipe cleaners, tape etc give your animal features such as scales, fur, ears or even a tail!
